What's Involved?

Game Referee

The referee will observe the robot game match closely, and "score" the team based on the game rules and mission descriptions.

In NorCal, we have over 2,500 9 to 14 year olds participating in FIRST LEGO League – we need adult judges and referees to give their time to celebrate the kids' achievements.

Teamwork Judge

Teamwork is judged on a team's ability to be enthusiastic, show partnership, respect for their teammates, support and encouragement for other teams. The FLL Core values are an important aspect.

Robot Design Judge

A panel of judges interview a team about the technical hurdles the team faced in their overall design, including the attachments and software programs developed for the LEGO robot.

Project Presentation Judge

Teams present their project to a panel of judges that typically has 3 components: 1) Identify issue, analyze data; 2) Create an innovative solution; 3) Share with others the team's research & solution.
